**134M LONG TANKER DRYDOCKED FOR SPECIAL SURVEY**

**AT TRIANGLE SHIPYARD (TMS)**

**AT DUBAI MARITIME CITY IN MARCH 2020**

**In March 2020 a 134m long bitumen tanker has been lifted to Triangle Marine facility at Dubai Maritime City, Dubai, the first time a longest vessel at DMC Shipyard.**
